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- 6. SR 2032 crosses, the tracks of Reading, Blue Mountain and Northern Railroad at Segment 60, Offset 0513. The ADT for SR 2032 is 7089 vehicles with 4% trucks.
- 7. The estimated total cost for the project is \$138,000.00. The funding for the project will be 80% Federal Funds and 20.% State Funds.
- 8. This project is necessary and proper for the safety and convenience of the public.
- 9. A conference of all parties of interest should be held to discuss the proposed alteration.
