- 3 XO Communications wishes to construct a communication facility in the Borough of East Lampeter, Lancaster County. To complete the system, the communication facility must cross Norfolk Southern Railroad tracks along Greenfield Road within Norfolk Southern's right-of-way. The communication facility will be placed above ground from PPL Pole 41833/S26346 to PPL Pole 41831/S26351. This is an existing crossing being relocated to comply with height requirements and warning devises.
- 4. The proposed construction will be a communication facility placed between existing utility poles on either side of the railroad crossing. The fiber optic communication facility will be aerial. Greenfield Road intersects the railroad above grade. See attached plan and profile. The completion date for this project is to be determined.
