

Paratransit Tariff naming Rates, Rules and Regulations Governing the
Transportation of Persons in Paratransit Service between Points in Pennsylvania

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in paratransit
Service, limited to persons whose personal convictions prevent them from owning or
operating motor vehicles, from points in Clearfield County, to points in Pennsylvania,
and return.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) Advance reservations must be made at least 2 hours prior to the service being rendered.
- 2) Rates for mileage will be computed by the use of the odometer of the vehicle being used and begin when the vehicle leaves the carrier's premises. The final mileage rating is determined upon return to the carrier's premises.
- 3) Carrier requires a deposit of not more than 20% of the quoted charter price. Forfeiture of deposits are within the following limitations:
 - (a) Forfeiture of not more than 50% of the deposit if the charter is cancelled by the customer more than 15 but less than 30 days prior to the date the transportation was to depart, and
 - (b) Forfeiture of not more than the total amount of the deposit if the cancellation occurs within 15 days prior to the date the transportation was to depart.
- 4) If any trip requires the vehicle and driver to remain at destination overnight, or at any point en route to destination overnight, the patron will be responsible for providing carrier's driver with accommodations at overnight facility (motel, hotel) being utilized by patron and all meals required by the carrier's driver.
