

**NOTE 1 - MINIMUM TRANSPORTATION CHARGES:**

Sundays and Holidays (any hour): 4 hours plus travel time at rates named in Columns 1 and 2.

Saturdays (any hour): 4 hours plus travel time at rates named in Columns 1 and 4.

▲◆Weekdays (any hour): 3 hours plus travel time at rates named in Columns 1 and 3.

**NOTE AA -** A flat charge based on one hour at the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, or 4 will be assessed when the distance from original point of origin to final destination is 20 miles or less.  
 A flat charge based on one and one-half hours at the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 will be assessed when the distance from original point of origin to final destination is over 20 miles but not exceeding 30 miles.  
 A flat charge based on two hours at the applicable transportation rate shown in Columns 2, 3, or 4 will be assessed when the distance from original point of origin to final destination is more than 30 miles (to 40 miles inclusive).
