3. On December 23, 2014, I&E filed a Motion to Strike Glenn's Answer to the Complaint.¹ I&E argued that Respondent's Answer is untimely and unresponsive to the allegations in I&E's Complaint. Further, I&E argued that the documents that Respondent submitted appear to demonstrate that Respondent violated Section 510(b) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 510(b), by failing to submit assessment reports by the statutory deadline of March 31 each year.
4. By Hearing Notice dated March 23, 2015, an Initial Hearing is scheduled in this matter for Wednesday, May 6, 2015 at 10:00 AM in Harrisburg, PA before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Elizabeth H. Barnes.
5. By Order entered on March 25, 2015, I&E's Motion to Strike was denied and Respondent was provided with twenty (20) days from the date of entry of the Order, or by April 14, 2015, to file an Answer to I&E's Complaint.
6. As of the date of filing the instant Motion for Continuance, I&E has not received an Answer from Respondent related to I&E's Complaint and the docket of this matter does not reflect that an Answer has been received.
7. The I&E prosecuting attorney assigned to handle this matter has a hearing scheduled in Pittsburgh on Wednesday, May 6, 2015 at 9:00 AM in C-2014-2422723.
8. I&E respectfully requests a continuance of the Initial Hearing in the above captioned matter and suggests three alternative dates in which counsel for I&E and I&E's witness are available: May 13, 14 and 15, 2015.

¹ Glenn's Answer to the I&E Complaint was not served upon I&E. Consequently, I&E was not aware of Glenn's pleading until several months after it was filed.

9. Respondent does not object to I&E's request for a continuance or the three alternative hearing dates proposed by I&E.

WHEREFORE, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement respectfully requests that the hearing scheduled for May 6, 2015 in the above captioned-matter be continued.
