

2. Members of RESA include NGSs that currently serve residential, commercial and industrial customers in Columbia's service territory. As such, they have a direct and immediate interest in any tariff modifications that could affect their ability to serve those customers. They also have a substantial interest in any new or existing tariff provisions that have impacted or will impact their ability to economically and effectively serve retail customers on Columbia's system.


4. RESA is still reviewing Columbia's filing and intends to focus on any issues raised by Columbia's filing and testimony submitted by other parties that will have an adverse impact on the competitive natural gas retail market or the business operations of NGSs serving retail customers in Columbia's service territory. A particular issue of interest that RESA has identified is Columbia's proposal for a Choice Administration Charge ("CAC"), which would be billed as a per therm rate for Choice customers and included in the Pass-through Charge line item on their bills. CAC costs would also be allocated to General Distribution Service customers as a fixed charge. These charges are described as a carve out of costs that Columbia incurs to administer, enhance and maintain gas transportation programs.

5. Because RESA members include licensed NGSs that serve customers in Columbia's service territory, they have a direct, immediate and substantial interest that cannot be adequately represented by any other party to this proceeding, and they clearly will be bound by any decision that the Commission might make with regard to Columbia's requested rate increase and accompanying tariff changes. They likewise have a direct, immediate and substantial interest in reviewing and responding, as necessary, to proposals submitted by other parties in this proceeding. RESA is an entity distinct from any individual NGS that may be participating in this proceeding. RESA's interests are therefore not necessarily protected by those interventions. Therefore, RESA requests that its intervention be granted and that it be allowed full party status in this matter.

WHEREFORE, the Retail Energy Supply Association hereby files this Petition to Intervene and requests full party status.
