Dear Secretary McNulty:

MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. and its affiliates set forth below (collectively, "MCI") respectfully request an extension of time to file only its Class C Annual Reports for year ending December 31, 2002. MCI had previously requested extensions until May 30, 2003 and June 30, 2003, respectively, which extensions were previously granted. See letters dated April 24, 2003 and May 29, 2003 from Melissa A. Burris, Staff Specialist to James J. McNulty, attached as Exhibits "A" and "B", respectively, and incorporated by reference. Said extensions were granted by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") by letters dated April 28, 2003 and June 6, 2003. Copies of the April 28, 2003 and June 6, 2003, letters from Robert F. Wilson, Manager, Bureau of Fixed Utility Services to Melissa A. Burris are attached as Exhibits "C" and "D", respectively, and incorporated by reference. While those earlier requested extensions were for a greater number of companies and a greater number of reports, MCI is pleased to advise that has already filed all reports pursuant to the earlier requests for extension, except for the Class C Annual Reports for the three (3) companies listed below. Thus, it is for only the three companies below that MCI is hereby requesting additional time to file only the Class C Annual Reports.

The companies for which MCI is requesting an extension to file, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 63.36, its 2002 Class C Annual Reports are the following:

- MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. A-310580
- MCI metro Access Transmission Services, LLC -A-310752
- Intermedia Communications, Inc. A-310401

As previously explained in MCI's prior requests for extension, MCI is in the process of restating its financial reports for all of its companies as a result of discoveries in June 2002 of various financial irregularities. As a result of those discoveries, MCI began a comprehensive audit of its 2001 and 2002 financials.

As a direct result of the discovery of the financial irregularities, MCI filed for bankruptcy protection in July 2002. Subsequently, in August 2002, MCI discovered additional accounting irregularities and expanded the comprehensive audit to include reviewing financials for the year 2000. Once the audits are complete, MCI will be restating the financials for the same time periods.


Accordingly, MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. herein is requesting on behalf of itself, and its noted affiliates, an extension of time in which to file its 2002 Annual Reports until ninety (90) days after the audited financials and restatements are complete. AFFIDAVIT OF ANASTASIA D. KELLY

I, Anastasia D. Kelly, Secretary of MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc., MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC, and Intermedia Communications, Inc. (hereinafter collectively referred to as "MCI"), an adult individual, do hereby affirm that the information set forth below is true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief.

1. On July 21, 2002, WorldCom, Inc. and certain of its direct and indirect subsidiaries commenced voluntary cases under Chapter 11 of the United States Code ("Bankruptcy Code") in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York.

2. Included in the bankruptcy filings were, among others, MCI.

3. As a result of accounting irregularities which precipitated the need for MCI to file for bankruptcy, MCI undertook extensive accounting audits of its year 2000, 2001 and 2002 financials. The results of those audits will cause MCI to restate its financials for the same time periods.

4. Despite the good faith efforts of MCI, those audits have taken longer to complete than originally anticipated.

5. Until such time as MCI has completed the audits and restated its financials, however, MCI is unable to complete and submit its Class C Annual Reports for the specified companies.

6. As such, MCI is requesting an extension of time for just cause.




