Re: Public Power, LLC- Docket #A-2009-2143245

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Public Power, LLC ("Public Power") was licensed as an Electric Generation Supplier on January 28, 2010. Public Power is submitting this letter to comply with Section 54.34 of the regulations of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the "Commission").

As a result of an April 1, 2015 Acquisition among TriEagle Energy LP ("TriEagle") and Crius Energy LLC ("Crius"), certain changes have occurred that may trigger the reporting requirements of Sections 54.34(a) and (b). This letter discloses those changes.

Section 54.34

Public Power has become affiliated with an additional licensed competitive retail electricity supplier that supplies this commodity to customers in several states. The new affiliation has materialized as a result of the above-mentioned Acquisition. On April 1, 2015 Crius acquired TriEagle and created two entities: TriEagle 1, LLC ("TE1") and TriEagle 2, LLC ("TE2"), both Nevada limited liability companies.



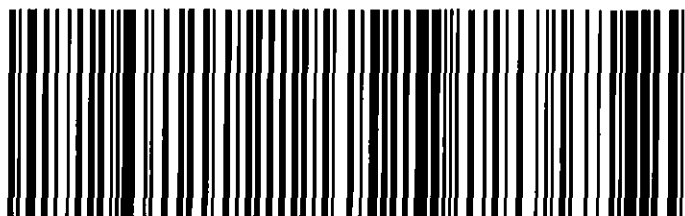
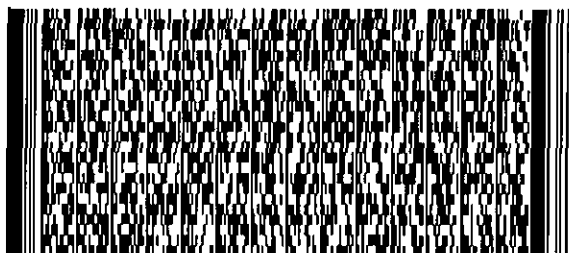
