
**DOCUMENT FOLDER**

By Order entered March 15, 2002, at Docket Nos. A-311139 and A-311139 F0002 the Commission approved the application of Citizens Telecom Solutions, LLC Co. to provide service, as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier and as a Reseller of Interexchange Toll Services to the public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The Company has filed PA PUC Tariff Telephone No.'s 1 and 3 with an effective date of July 18, 2002. In compliance to the aforementioned Commission Order, the Company has filed Switched Access Tariff No. 2, effective July 18, 2002, as part of its CLEC authority.

This letter is to notify you that the CLEC Tariff No. 1 and the IXC Tariff No. 3 have been permitted to become effective. This permission does not constitute a determination that the tariffs are just, lawful, or reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time.

The determination to permit the tariffs to become effective is without prejudice to any complaint timely filed against the proposed tariffs.
