
Dear Ms. Tipps:

By Order entered May 9, 2002, at Docket No's. A-311140, A-311140 F0002, and A-311140 F0004, the Commission approved the application of AT&T Broadband Phone, LLC to provide service as a Reseller of Interexchange Toll Services, as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier and as a facilities-based Interexchange Carrier to the public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The Company has filed PA PUC Tariff Telephone No's 1, 2 and 3, with an effective date of July 19, 2002. As part of the CLEC authority the Company has filed Switched Access Tariff Pa. PUC No. 4, with the same effective date as PA PUC No's 1, 2, and 3.

This letter is to notify you that the CLEC Tariff No. 1, the Facilities-Based IXC Tariff No. 2, and the IXC Reseller Tariff No. 3 have been permitted to become effective. This permission does not constitute a determination that the tariffs are just, lawful, or reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time.

The determination to permit the tariffs to become effective is without prejudice to any complaint timely filed against the proposed tariffs.
