

For approval to offer, render, furnish or supply telecommunication services
to the public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

Dear Ms Klinzman:

On September 30, 2004, Granite Telecommunications, LLC (Granite) was authorized by Commission Order to provide telecommunications service to the public as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) and as an Interexchange Toll Reseller (IXC). The authority is subject to the filing of tariffs addressing certain deficiencies listed in Appendix A of the Order. In light of Granite's recent explanation that its "dedicated services" included in the IXC tariff are actually connected to the Public Switched Network, staff has removed the requirement that Granite file an application and tariff as a Competitive Access Provider (CAP). Therefore, Granite may disregard paragraph #3 of Appendix A, found on page 12. Granite is encouraged to include clearer tariff language with the filing of its initial IXC tariff.
