Dear Ms. Klinzman:

By Order entered October 1, 2004, at Docket Nos. A-311204 and A-311204F0002, the Commission approved the application of Granite Telecommunications, LLC. (GRANITE) to provide service as a Toll Reseller (IXC) in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and as a Reseller and Facilities-based Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) within the service territories of Verizon Pennsylvania Inc., Verizon North Inc., and Sprint/United Telephone Company of Pennsylvania in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The Company has filed PA PUC Tariff No. 1 with an effective date of October 21, 2004, PA PUC Tariff Telephone No. 2 with an effective date of October 29, 2004, and PA PUC Tariff Telephone No. 3 with an effective date of June 30, 2004.


This letter is to notify you that IXC Tariff No. 1, CLEC Tariff No. 2, and Switched Access Tariff No. 3 have been permitted to become effective. This permission does not constitute a determination that the tariffs are just, lawful, or reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time.

GRANITE is also directed to add its Pennsylvania tariffs to its website within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter. Upon placing the tariffs on its website, GRANITE shall contact Cyndi Page (717-787-5722; cypage@state.pa.us) of the Commission's Communications Office to inform her of the tariffs' website address. In order to maintain a true and accurate representation of its tariffs on file with the Commission, GRANITE should continually update its tariffs whenever supplemental revisions are approved by the Commission.

If GRANITE does not maintain a website, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission will host its tariffs on the Commission's website. Contact Cyndi Page for instructions on how to have your tariffs and/or tariff supplements added to the Commission's website.

The determination to permit the tariffs to become effective is without prejudice to any complaint timely filed against the proposed tariffs.
