The bill is overdue when not paid on or before the due date indicated on the bill. An overdue bill is subject to a Late Payment Charge of 1.25% interest per month on the full unpaid and overdue balance of the charges billed by the Company including EGS charges for those customers who have selected consolidated billing. The Late Payment Charge shall be calculated on the overdue portion(s) of the charges on the bill and shall not be charged against any sum that falls due during a current billing period. A Late Payment Charge on a disputed bill may be reduced or eliminated by the Company, or upon order by the Commission, to facilitate payment by the disputing customer.
