MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO Energy"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby requests a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter and states the following:

1. A telephonic hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Monday, May 20, 2015 at 10:00 a.m.
2. The Complainant alleges in his formal complaint that there are underground cable faults on his line that have caused him property damage.
3. During a recent pre-hearing resolution meeting at the Complainant's residence, PECO agreed the company would dig up the area at issue so that PECO could inspect the cables.
4. PECO is presently scheduling a work order to perform the dig in order to investigate the Complainant's concerns.
5. The company anticipates the work will be performed within the next 45 days.
6. Accordingly, PECO Energy is requesting a continuance of the hearing to schedule a dig at the area in dispute to determine if the underground cables have been properly repaired.
7. PECO Energy will offer a report and photographs of the underground cable at issue at the time of the hearing.
8. PECO Energy discussed this with the Complainant, Robert Barone, and he has jointly requested to continue this matter so the dig can be performed.

9. PECO Energy therefore respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to a further date.
