MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby requests a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter and states the following:

1. An in person further hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Thursday, May 14, 2015 at 10:00 a.m.
2. PECO is requesting a continuance of the May 15th hearing date because of the unavailability of PECO witness, High Bill Foreman, Thomas Lerro.
3. Mr. Lerro performed the high bill field investigation at the Complainant's residence on February 20, 2015, and will testify to the high bill report the company will produce at the hearing.
4. Mr. Lerro is out of the office sick and does not expect to return to the office this week.
5. PECO therefore respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to a further date the last week of July 2015.
6. The Prehearing Order in this matter states that requests for a continuance are only granted "in rare situations where good cause exists." (Prehearing Order, citing 52 Pa. Code § 1.15).

7. PECO avers that “good cause” exists to continue the scheduled hearing to another date because one of PECO’s witnesses is unavailable.

8. PECO contacted the Complainant, Peter Mordeczko, and he does not consent to the company’s continuance request.

9. PECO therefore respectfully requests that the further hearing be continued to a further date.
