On March 27, 2015, PECO Energy Company filed Original Tariff Electric-Pa. P.U.C. No. 5, containing proposed changes in distribution rates of approximately \$190 million. Original Tariff No. 5 bears a proposed effective date of May 26, 2015.

On April 23, 2015, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission issued an Order at Docket No. R-2015-2468981, proposing Original Tariff Electric-Pa. P.U.C. No. 5 be suspended by operation of law until December 26, 2015, unless otherwise directed by Order of the Commission.

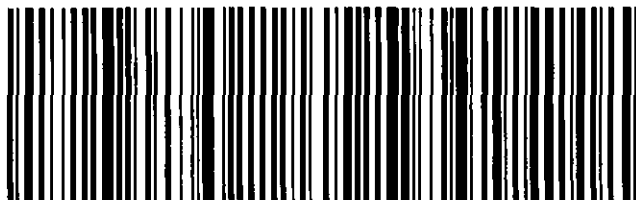
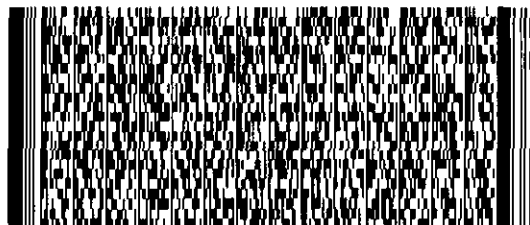
