Enclosed for filing on behalf of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL Electric") is PPL Electric's Updated Final Calculation of the Phase 1 Act 129 Compliance Rider ("ACR 1") for the Application Period of June 1, 2015 through May 31, 2016. This calculation report, which is being filed pursuant to the procedures set forth in PPL Electric's Tariff - Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 201, reflects actual data through April 30, 2015. This filing provides revised pages that were previously filed with the May 1 calculation under the above referenced docket. There are no changes to the rate, which remains at \$0.0 for all customer classes.

The ACR-1 Large C&I is proposed to be set to \$0.00, effective June 1, 2015. The remaining under collected balance will be transferred to ACR-2 and be included in the June 1, 2015 rate calculation.
