# AMENDMENT ONE TO THE INTERCONNECTION AND TRAFFIC INTERCHANGE AGREEMENT FOR CELLULAR AND OTHER 2-WAY RADIO SERVICES

This Amendment One to the Interconnection and Traffic Interchange Agreement for Cellular and Other 2-Way Radio Services ("Agreement") between those divisions and/or subsidiaries of Frontier Communications of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Frontier") and Southwestern Bell Mobile Systems, LLC dba Cingular Wireless ("Carrier") is made on this 11th day of November, 2004. Frontier and Carrier are referred to herein collectively as the "Parties".

Frontier and Carrier entered into the Agreement on June 24, 2003.

Frontier and Carrier desire to amend the Agreement.

In consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Amend existing Agreement to include the following legal entities:

Frontier Communications of Lakewood, LLC Frontier Communications of Breezewood, LLC Frontier Communications of Canton, LLC Frontier Communications of Oswayo River, LLC

2. Amend existing Agreement to include a new Service Attachment attached hereto:

# **Section 1 - Description**

Carrier Name: Southwestern Bell Mobile Systems, LLC

The Point of Interconnection (POI) for this indirect interconnection is at the local exchange boundary of Frontier.

# Section 2 - Usage Sensitive Charges

2.1 Charges for Reciprocal Transport and Termination of Local Traffic Interchanged Between The Parties:

The land-to-mobile originating rate is limited in application to Land-to-Mobile (Originating) calls that originate in the Frontier Local Calling Area at the Point of Interconnection. The mobile-to-land terminating rate is limited in application to Mobile-to-Land (Terminating) calls that terminate at a point within a Frontier Exchange Area in Carrier's Service Area. All other traffic is subject to access rates.

The rates in this Section 2 constitute compensation to the Parties for both the transport and termination of local traffic interchanged between them.

2.2 Mobile-to-Land (Terminating) per minute\* \$0.0112
Land-to-Mobile (Customer charges Frontier) per minute \$0.0112
Tandem Transit \$0.0061854
Non-MTA\*\* Access rates apply

\*limited in application to calls originating on Carrier's system within its Service Area and terminating at a point in a Frontier exchange area within the MTA

\*\*applicable to mobile-to-land (terminating) calls terminating at a point in a Frontier exchange area but which did not originate on Carrier's system within Service Area

#### Section 3 - Network Facilities

This Agreement relates to the exchange of Local Traffic between the respective networks of Carrier and Frontier, which uses the tandem switching facilities of a third party. Unless a direct connection is separately negotiated, no network facilities between the Parties will be used.

If Frontier is requested to provide facilities between the Point of Interconnection and any Carrier facilities or locations within Frontier Service Area, such facilities will be provided pursuant to the special access

services' provisions of Frontier FCC #1 Tariff. The rates for such facilities are subject to change during the term of this Agreement.

When Carrier indirectly interconnects with a Frontier End Office and Local Traffic is exchanged between the Parties, the Parties agree to establish a direct two-way Type 2B trunk if the traffic exchanged during the busy hour in centum call seconds (CCS) reaches a DS1level (512 CCS) at least 15 times per month or 8 times per day. During peak seasonal calling periods or times of crisis the Parties agree to work together to determine if direct two-way facilities are required.


