Dear Mr. Ferenchak:

By Order entered January 25, 2006, at the above-referenced docket numbers, the Commission approved the applications of CityNet Pennsylvania, LLC (Company) to provide service to the public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as a Reseller of Interexchange Toll Services, a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier, a Competitive Access Provider and a Facilities-based Interexchange Carrier. In order to obtain Certificates of Public Convenience to provide these services, initial tariffs must be submitted for Commission approval. On May 9, 2006, the Company filed Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. No. 1, Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. No. 2, Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. No. 3 and Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. No 4 with effective dates of May 12, 2006.

This letter is to notify you that Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. No. 1, Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. No. 2, Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. No. 3 and Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. No. 4 have been permitted to become effective. This permission does not constitute a determination that the tariffs are just, lawful, or reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time.


The Company is also directed to add its Pennsylvania tariffs to its website within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter. In order to maintain a true and accurate representation of its tariffs on file with the Commission, the Company should continually update its tariffs whenever supplemental revisions are approved by the Commission.
