
In the Commission's letter dated May 27, 2015, the authority of Wagners Express, LLC (Wagners) was cancelled for failure to maintain evidence of insurance. Additionally, Wagners was fined \$500, and PennDOT was notified to suspend all motor vehicle registrations.

The reason the company's insurance was cancelled was that it had ceased operations. I apologize for the company's failure to notify the Commission that we had closed the business and were no longer operating.

I have paid the \$500 fine and am requesting that the Commission contact PennDOT to release the hold on vehicle registrations. Wagners is no longer providing service in PA. Furthermore, Wagners will cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§1.1 et seq. and the regulations of the Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1 et seq.
