Dear Secretary Alford:

On behalf of our client, R.A.M. Transit Lines, Incorporated (R.A.M. Transit), we petition to have the above-referenced application reinstated and the Secretarial letter of April 19, 1995, withdrawn.

On August 3, 1994, R.A.M. Transit filed an application for transfer of motor carrier rights. Notice of the application was published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin on September 4, 1994. By Order entered October 21, 1994 the Commission approved the unopposed application subject to certain filing requirements including general liability and cargo insurance. On April 19, 1995, a Secretarial letter was issued informing R.A.M. Transit that its application was being marked "closed for lack of prosecution". Upon receipt of that letter, counsel for R.A.M. Transit determined that R.A.M. Transit's insurance carrier made the Form H cargo liability insurance filing, however, a Form E had not been filed. Apparently R.A.M. Transit's insurance carrier did not believe it was necessary to file another Form E because it had filed a Form E with this Commission on or about August 25, 1994. On or about April 25, 1995, R.A.M. Transit's insurance carrier made another Form E filing which demonstrates that R.A.M. Transit has had liability insurance in continuous effect since June 1, 1994. A copy of the this Form E filing is attached.


