12.3.7 Core Solutions (Option 2 with ISP)

A. Monthly Rate

Core Solutions (Option 2 with ISP) is a competitive bundled service that offers a basic exchange access line, unlimited calling to parties located in the Customer's local calling areas (as established in Section 12.2.4 of this Tariff), unlimited Long Distance calling unlimited Dial Up Internet service, and any of the features listed in Section B below for the following single monthly rate to Residential Customers. This plan includes an option to purchase services that are not regulated by the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission.

	<u>Monthly Rate</u>	
- All Access Areas, first line	\$58.90	(R)
- All Access Areas, each additional line	\$22.95	

These monthly charges apply in addition to all other applicable charges, including those established in Section 12.2.5 of this Tariff. Core Solutions plan includes unlimited calling during all time-of-day rate periods for direct dialed 1+ interLATA interstate, interLATA intrastate, intraLATA interstate, and intraLATA intrastate domestic calls.

Minutes used for Operator Assisted Calling, Calling Card, Toll Free Service, Directory Assistance, and International calling are excluded. Unlimited long distance service is for residential domestic direct-dial calls within the 50 U.S. states. Long distance calling for business or Internet access is not included. If the Core Solutions plan is used for non-residential use as described previously, customer will be moved to a measured long distance service plan.

12.3.5 Core100 (Option 2 with ISP)

A. Monthly Rate

Core100 is a competitive bundled service that offers a basic exchange access line, unlimited calling to parties located in the Customer's local calling areas (as established in Section 12.2.4 of this Tariff), unlimited Long Distance calling unlimited Dial Up Internet service, and any of the features listed in Section B below for the following single monthly rate to Residential Customers. Core 100 also includes 100 minutes of switched outbound intraLATA and interLATA MTS long distance per month for no additional charge. Usage over 100 minutes a month will be billed at the rates listed in Section C below.

- All Access Areas	\$41.90
- Strategic Alliance Rate	\$22.95

These monthly charges apply in addition to all other applicable charges, including those established in Section 12.2.5 of this Tariff.
