OPINION AND ORDER

DOCKETED
FEB 14 1995

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 30, 1994, Pennsylvania Power & Light Company ("Respondent") filed Supplement No. 50 to Tariff Electric-Pa. P.U.C. No. 200, to become effective February 28, 1995, containing proposed changes in rates, rules and regulations calculated to produce \$261,635,000 in additional annual revenues, based upon the level of operations in the twelve months ended September 30, 1995. Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. 1308(d), the filing will be suspended by operation of law until September 28, 1995, unless permitted by Commission Order to become effective at an earlier date.

Investigation and analysis of the tariff filing and supporting data indicates that the proposed changes in rates, rules and regulations may be unlawful, unjust, unreasonable and contrary to the public interest. It also appears that consideration should be given to the reasonableness of Respondent's existing rates, rules and regulations.

**THEREFORE,
IT IS ORDERED:**

1. That an investigation on Commission motion is hereby instituted to determine the lawfulness, justness, and reasonableness of the rates, rules and regulations proposed in Supplement No. 50 to Tariff Electric-Pa. P.U.C. No. 200.

2. That Supplement No. 50 to Tariff Electric-Pa. P.U.C. No. 200 be, and hereby is, suspended until September 28, 1995, unless otherwise directed by Order of this Commission.


3. That the Office of Administrative Law Judge shall assign this matter to an Administrative Law Judge for issuance of a recommended decision and shall schedule such hearings as may be necessary.

4. That the Office of Trial Staff shall participate in any proceeding before the Administrative Law Judge.

5. That this investigation shall include consideration of the lawfulness, justness, and reasonableness of Respondent's existing rates, rules and regulations.

6. That a copy of this Opinion and Order shall be served upon the Respondent and any persons who have filed formal complaints against Respondent's proposed rate changes.
