TO: Pennsylvania Power & Light Company:

On May 13, 1997, the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania decided the Petition for Review of the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA), which sought review of the Order of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission entered in Docket No. R-00943271, which was a general rate increase proceeding of Pennsylvania Power & Light Company.

The Commonwealth Court reversed the determination of the Commission which rejected an OCA proposed adjustment of \$745,000 to reflect the impact of uncollectible revenues on the utility's Gross Receipts Tax obligations. 695 A.2d at 455.

In light of the fact that the Pennsylvania Supreme Court has denied the OCA's allocatur petition on September 30, 1997, there appears to be no further proceedings in this matter other than the Commission's implementation of the remand directive.

Pennsylvania Power & Light Company is, hereby, directed to file a refund schedule implementing the refund of the uncollectible revenues on its Gross Receipts Tax expense within ten (10) days of the date of the Secretarial Letter. All parties to the base rate proceeding shall be served a copy of the refund schedule and will be permitted twenty days in which to file any objection.
