Re: Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. Natural Gas Suppliers (“NGS”) serving Choice Customers located in Pipeline Scheduling Point 25-36

Dear Natural Gas Supplier:

This letter is to inform you that due to extensive distribution system replacement requirements and costs, effective **July 1, 2016**, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. plans to take certain parts of its distribution system from Snowshoe to State College out of service permanently such that customers located in the State College area will only be served through either Dominion Transmission (“DTI”) or Texas Eastern Transmission (“TETCO”). Deliveries to this area through Columbia Gas Transmission (“CPG”) will no longer be available. The State College market is located within Pipeline Scheduling Point (“PSP”) 25-36 and, although deliveries into this PSP for the State College market will need to be delivered through DTI or TETCO, all other markets in PSP 25-36, outside of the State College market, will still require deliveries through CPG.

NGSs serving Choice customers within PSP 25-36, effective **July 1, 2016** and continuing thereafter, will be required to deliver a portion of their Choice Daily Delivery Requirement through DTI (approximately 55% and subject to change) and the remainder of the Choice Daily Delivery Requirement through CPG (approximately 45% and subject to change). Firm transportation capacity will be released to the NGS on both DTI and CPG in accordance with these percentages. Nominations in Aviator will continue to be directed to the existing nomination groups, regardless of the delivering pipeline.

Again, deliveries to the State College area through CPG in Pipeline Scheduling Point (“PSP”) 25-36 will no longer be available as of July 1, 2016.

Columbia has completed a thorough review of the pipeline distribution facilities from Snowshoe to State College and due to extensive pipeline replacement requirements and costs, Columbia plans to permanently take out of service certain parts of this pipeline distribution system. Columbia is notifying you at this time in order to provide you with adequate time to secure alternate capacity and/or supply options. Please feel free to contact DTI or TETCO at your convenience to explore alternatives.

The State College market is located within PSP 25-36, and although deliveries into this PSP for the State College market will need to be delivered through DTI or TETCO, all other markets in PSP 25-36, outside of the State College market, will still require deliveries through CPG.
