ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 31, 1996, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety instituted a complaint at A-00111786C9601 against Lawrence Estenich Enterprises, Inc., t/d/b/a Estenich Trucking Company alleging that it failed to obey and comply with a Commission Secretarial letter directing it to submit its company to a safety fitness review, and, for failure to maintain adequate, efficient and safe service and facilities.

Respondent was duly notified that, if an answer was filed which admitted or failed to deny the allegations in the complaint, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety would request the Commission to enter an order imposing a penalty.


On June 27, 1996, respondent filed an answer to the complaint which admitted the allegations contained therein. We will proceed with respondent's answer to the complaint.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the allegations in the complaint are admitted.
2. That the complaint is sustained.
3. That the certificate of public convenience held by Lawrence Estenich Enterprises, Inc., t/d/b/a Estenich Trucking Company at A-00111786 is hereby revoked without prejudice of respondent's right to file a new application.
4. That Lawrence Estenich Enterprises, Inc., t/d/b/a Estenich Trucking Company cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§101, et seq. and the regulations of this Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1, et seq. In view of the cancellation of

respondent's certificate of public convenience, it is specifically prohibited from rendering service as a common carrier by motor vehicle in intrastate commerce in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
