

WHEREFORE, Respondent requests that the proceedings against him be terminated and any fines or penalties waived due to the circumstances described herein.

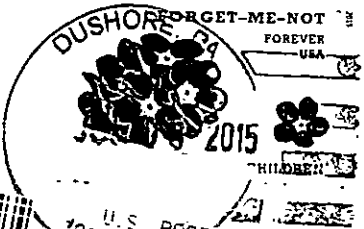
