RE: Exceptions of Diane and Stephen Van Schoyck

To the Secretary of the Commission,

The formal complaint filed by Stephen and Diane Van Schoyck against PECO Energy Company at docket Number C-2015-2478239 has been dismissed with no hearing held. The PUC and Federal Communications Commission have rubber stamped utility safety of these meters.

Exception #1

An AMI Smart Meter was installed on our private property against our will or knowledge. Smart meters are radiation-emitting devices that are licensed radio stations. They transmit electrical usage, occupancy times and other information thereby providing wiretapping without proper and legal search warrants.

Exception #2

The Federal Energy Act of 2005 states clearly that "smart" meters are to be offered to residential customers, not mandated or forced.

There is no OPT OUT of these meters in the state of PA. This should be illegal. I believe this is an act of extortion.

PA State Representative Bob Godshall is committing a crime against the democratic principles of governance by deliberately dis-allowing constituents, voters—and citizens in general—to exercise their right of redress and input regarding issues that affect them, their lives, and the safety of their possessions refusing to look at House bills 396, 393, 394, 395 that would allow a smart meter OPT OUT in Pennsylvania.

There is conflict of interest as Mr. Godshall's son works for Peco and the Smart Meter installation. There may be an ethics violation in this regard.

Exception #3


Since the insulation of an AMI Smart Meter on our home in February 2015 subsequent health issues and concerns have been presented. I suffer from electro-sensitivity and have removed all wireless devices from my home. I am being forced to live with wireless transmission 24/7 with the installation of this meter. I have extreme chest tightness and pain and suffer from sleep problems as well as a host of other symptoms, which are being documented by my doctor. There may be a personal injury or class action suit if the damages to my health continue.

There may be additional facts that could change the conclusion of this complaint. I believe that may concern is of public interest. When more people in Pennsylvania learn what a smart meter really is and more homes catch on fire and people become ill, my concerns will be validated.

The exercise to file this complaint has been achieved. A record has been established. The outcome was inevitable


given the fact that there was no due process or support of the Constitution of these United States.
