SECOND ORDER RE TRANSCRIPT CORRECTIONS

On August 19, 2004, in response to proposed transcript corrections from PPL Electric, the ALJ emailed to all the litigation parties the text of the Commission's regulation on transcript corrections, 52 Pa. Code §5.253. She encouraged the parties to stipulate to corrections where possible, and to file any proposed corrections as soon as possible so that she could rule on them in time for inclusion of the accepted corrections in the briefs. She recommended all who filed proposed corrections to follow PPL Electric's format.

On August 19, 23, and 24, 2004, PPL Electric and OSBA filed proposed corrections to the transcripts made for the hearings held on August 9, 11 and 12, 2004, and requested responses from the parties by dates certain, closing with Tuesday, August 31, 2004. PPL accepted an additional correction proposed by the ALJ.

The ALJ did not receive any other proposed corrections, nor any objections to the proposals of PPL Electric or OSBA, either directly or by referral from them.

The Commission's regulations authorize a correction of the transcript to be made "only to make it conform to the evidence presented at the hearing and to speak the truth". Proposed corrections may be submitted by stipulation of the participants or upon written request of the participants of record who were present when the transcription was taken. They may be

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filed within 30 days of the day the transcript was made or by permission of the presiding officer. Objections shall be filed in 15 days of receipt. Proposed corrections and objections shall be served on all litigation parties present when the transcript was taken. The presiding officer shall rule on requested corrections within thirty days of receipt or they will be deemed to be granted.
52 Pa. Code §5.253

In this case, because Main Briefs were due on September 2, 2004, the time periods for filing in the regulation were too relaxed to be practical. Having reviewed all the proposed corrections, and found none to be outside the standard of Section 5.253 (a), the ALJ adopted all but one of the proposed corrections in an Order Re Transcript Corrections served on August 31, 2004.

Then, on August 31, 2004, PPL Electric proposed two corrections to be made to the transcript for the hearing held on August 10, 2004. No party has objected to these proposed corrections. The ALJ has reviewed them, and finds them to be within the guidelines set forth in 52 Pa. Code §5.253.

The page with the two corrections is attached to this Order.

Since Main Briefs have been filed, the ALJ will not accept or rule on any further proposed transcript corrections.


ORDER
