**ORDER RE TRANSCRIPT CORRECTIONS**

On August 19, 2004, PPL Electric filed proposed corrections to the transcript made for the hearing held on August 9, 2004.

On August 19, 2004, the ALJ emailed to all the litigation parties the text of the Commission's regulation on transcript corrections, 52 Pa. Code §5.253. She encouraged the parties to stipulate to corrections where possible, and to file any proposed corrections as soon as possible so that she could rule on them in time for inclusion of the accepted corrections in the briefs. She recommended all who filed proposed corrections to follow PPL Electric's format.

On August 23, 2004, PPL Electric filed proposed corrections to the transcripts made for the hearings held August 11 and August 12, 2004. It stated that if it had not received objections by August 27, 2004, it would assume there were no objections, and would inform the ALJ accordingly.

On August 24, 2004, OSBA filed proposed corrections to the transcripts made for the hearings held on August 11 and 12, 2004, and requested responses by Tuesday, August 31, 2004.

On August 27, 2004, I proposed to PPL Electric to add a correction to one of its proposed corrections unless it objected. It has not.

In fact, I have not received any other proposed corrections, nor any objections to the proposals of PPL Electric or OSBA, either directly to me or by referral from them.

The Commission's regulations authorize a correction of the transcript to be made "only to make it conform to the evidence presented at the hearing and to speak the truth". Proposed corrections may be submitted by stipulation of the participants or upon written request of the participants of record who were present when the transcription was taken. They may be filed within 30 days of the day the transcript was made or by permission of the presiding officer. Objections shall be filed in 15 days of receipt. Proposed corrections and objections shall be served on all litigation parties present when the transcript was taken. The presiding officer shall rule on requested corrections within thirty days of receipt or they will be deemed to be granted. 52 Pa. Code §5.253


In this case, because Main Briefs are due on September 2, 2004, the time periods for filing in the regulation are too relaxed to be practical. Having reviewed all the proposed corrections, and found none to be outside the standard of Section 5.253 (a), I will adopt all but one of the proposed corrections [because it does not improve the line, at Tr. 987, line10], and with the permission of PPL Electric, have added a one-word correction [insert its for his at page 978, line 5] to those that have been proposed.

The pages of corrections are attached to this Order.

AND NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The proposed changes and corrections to the transcripts of the hearings held on August 9, 11, and 12, 2004, as amended, and as set forth in the pages

attached to this Order are hereby adopted, and shall be incorporated into the existing transcripts, and any references to or quotes from these parts of the transcript shall read accordingly.
