SECOND STATUS REPORT RE: DEFERRED DANACH LLC APPLICATION

On January 20, 2015 Judge Christopher Pell entered an order placing the above referenced application into a stay of further proceeding based on the request of the Applicant and the status of other Uber related Commission activity. As part of that order Judge Pell has requested that the Applicant provide a status report every sixty days until the matter is placed back on the dockets.


The Applicant reports as follows:

1. On January 29, 2015 after a recommended decision, a subsequent final decision from the Commission and the completion of a compliance plan, Rasier-PA LLC, a wholly owned Uber subsidiary was granted experimental authority by the Commission to operate in most of the counties of the Commonwealth including those sought by Danach LLC here
2. The operation of the experimental authority and its coordination with the compliance plan is still in the relatively beginning stages of operation
3. Legislation has been developed to take this new authority from experimental to a transportation authorized by the Legislature and regulated by the appropriate agency
4. As anticipated in the last report Legislation has been introduced into the Legislature and several bills are being considered by the House of Representatives, one of which was discussed in depth at a public hearing before the Committee on Consumer Affairs
5. Unfortunately, the budget for the Commonwealth still has not been resolved and this legislation, along with many other bills, have taken a back seat while the Legislature handles that battle.
6. The Legislature has now gone into recess without resolving the budget mater, but it is anticipated that this will be their top priority when they return in the end of August.

7. It is understood that there will be no activity on the Transportation Network Companies legislation until after the budget has been resolved
8. The development of this Legislation will govern how Danach LLC will operate in conjunction with this experimental authority or whether there will be a need for the authority at all
9. The Applicant still desires to obtain limousine authority with the Commission but seeks to continue the stay of proceedings until the Legislation is finalized and it is determined as to the necessity of service and eliminate any further time and expense that would be expended in litigating the Application at this time
10. The Applicant will file its next report by October 10, 2015 as ordered by Judge Pell unless terminating Application or ordered differently.
