**TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:**

Pennsylvania-American Water Company (“Pennsylvania American Water” or “PAWC”) by its attorneys have filed on December 31, 2014, pursuant to Section 1102(a) of the Public Utility Code (66 Pa.C.S. §1102(a)), an Application for Approval of (1) the transfer, by sale, of substantially all of McEwensville Municipal Authority properties and rights related to its public wastewater system to Pennsylvania-American Water Company, (2) the rights of Pennsylvania-American Water Company to begin to offer or furnish wastewater to the public in McEwensville Borough and a portion of Delaware Township, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania. Pennsylvania American Water now wishes to amend said Application. In support of this request, the Applicant states as follows:

### **Reason for Amendment**

By this Amendment, Pennsylvania American Water seeks permission to revise the Application by clarifying the service territory of the McEwensville Municipal Authority (“MBMA”) wastewater system.

### **Amendment**

Pennsylvania American Water hereby amends paragraph 26, specifically Exhibits M.1 and M.2, of the Application for the following reason:

After research and review with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (“DEP”) and discussions with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Pennsylvania American Water determined on August 12, 2015 the service territory as provided in the initial Application does not follow Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plans for McEwensville Borough and Delaware Township. In 2007, MBMA was one of four (4) municipalities (MBMA, Delaware Township, Watsonstown Borough, and Lewis Township) that joined together as the "Northern Neighbors" to prepare a combined Act 537 Plan. The Northern Neighbors Act 537 Plan was finalized in March 2009. DEP has confirmed that MBMA's sewer service area contained in The Northern Neighbors Act 537 Plan represents its Act 537 sewer service area. The amended service territory map will reflect this area.

Pennsylvania American Water hereby submits a revised M.1 (map) and Exhibit M.2 (description) of its application which represents the wastewater service territory as represented in the DEP approved Northern Neighbors Act 537 plan as it pertains to McEwensville Borough and Delaware Township.

This amendment replaces the amendment filed on July 21, 2015 and subsequently withdrawn on August 14, 2015.

WHEREFORE, the Pennsylvania American Water respectfully requests that the Commission issue the necessary certificate of public convenience approving the Application and its Amendment of Pennsylvania-American Water Company for Approval of (1) the transfer, by sale, of substantially

all of McEwensville Municipal Authority properties and rights related to its public wastewater system to Pennsylvania-American Water Company, (2) the rights of Pennsylvania-American Water Company to begin to offer or furnish wastewater to the public in McEwensville Borough and a portion of Delaware Township, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania.

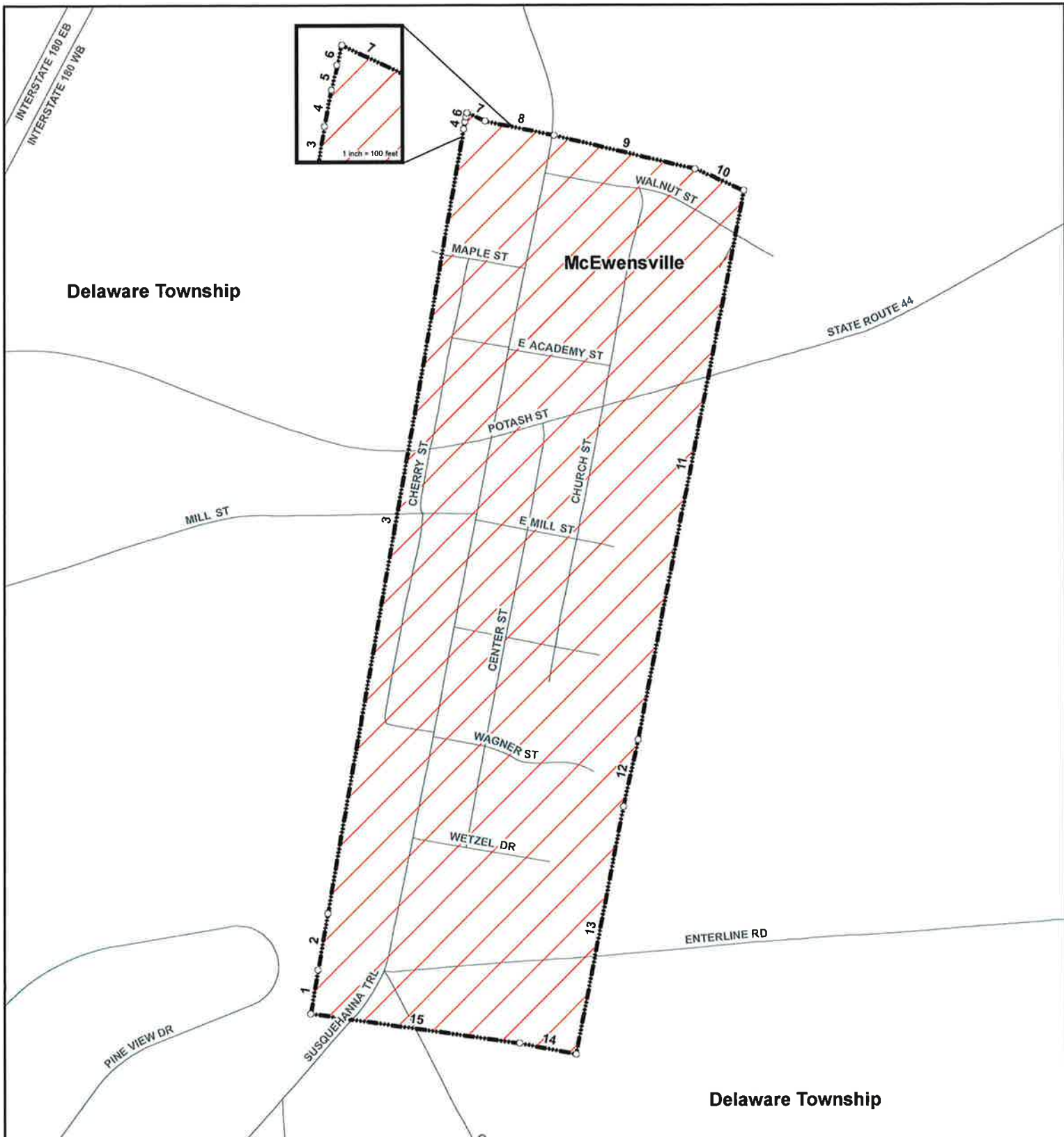

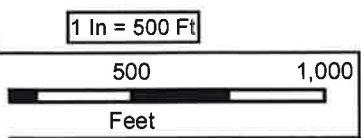
**Pennsylvania American Water Company**
