FIRST INTERIM ORDER

The following have filed petitions to intervene in this proceeding: International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 29 (IBEW); Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. and NRG Energy Center, Pittsburgh (jointly, Constellation/NRG); Citizen Power, Inc. (Citizen Power); Citizens for Pennsylvania's Future (PennFuture); Retail Energy Supply Association (RESA); Strategic Energy, LLC (Strategic); Direct Energy, LLC (Direct Energy); Reliant Energy, Inc. (Reliant); Comcast of California/Pennsylvania/Utah/Washington, Inc. (Comcast); Community Action Association of Pennsylvania (CAAP); Wal-Mart Stores East, LP. (Wal-Mart);

The petitions of IBEW and Constellation/NRG were granted at the prehearing conference held May 12, 2006. Duquesne Light filed an answer to the petitions of Citizen Power, PennFuture, CAAP and RESA. As indicated in these answers, Duquesne does not object to these interventions, but reserves the right to object to issues raised by these parties that are outside the scope of the proceeding. In an email sent to all parties on June 20, 2006, counsel for Duquesne Light repeats that Duquesne Light reserves the right to object to issues raised by any party that are outside the scope of the proceeding, but specifically responded to these petitions to intervene based on the allegations contained therein. The email also states that Duquesne Light does not object to the interventions of Direct Energy, Strategic, Comcast, and Reliant. Finally, the email states that (1) Duquesne Light does not object to Wal-Mart's intervention on the express condition that Wal-Mart accept the schedule as it stands, and (2) that counsel for Wal-Mart has expressly stated that Wal-Mart accepts the schedule as it stands.

Duquesne Light has the right to object to issues raised by any party on the grounds that they are outside the scope of this proceeding. Wal-Mart must accept the schedule set forth in the prehearing order of this proceeding.

The order below grants the petitions to intervene.


THEREFORE;
