It was the policy of the McEwensville Municipal Authority when I was hired on October 1, 1997 to charge multiple EDU's for properties containing more than one dwelling unit. At the time of the establishment of the system, property owners were not required to install multiple water meters if they had multiple EDU's. The only verification for this policy I was able to locate is in Resolution #3 adopted September 20, 1983, Section 1C, where it *defines a "dwelling unit" as any room, group of rooms, house trailer or other enclosure occupied or intended for occupancy as separate living quarters by a family or other group of persons living together or by persons living alone and also shall mean any room, group of rooms or other enclosure occupied or used as a store, office, profession or other business venture or used for municipal purposes or as a fire house, clubrooms, church or for any single purpose.* While this Resolution was adopted for sewer rates, etc. the same rules have been used for both the water and sewer billing.

I hope this information helps to better explain the billing procedure used by the Authority.

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A RESOLUTION

FIXING AND CHARGING SEWER RATES AND OTHER CHARGES FOR USE OF THE SEWAGE COLLECTION AND TREATMENT SYSTEM TO BE ACQUIRED, CONSTRUCTED, OWNED AND OPERATED BY THIS AUTHORITY AND FOR COLLECTING, TRANSPORTING AND DISPOSING OF WASTES DISCHARGED THERETO, UPON OWNERS OF IMPROVED PROPERTY CONNECTED TO SUCH SEWAGE COLLECTION AND TREATMENT SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR COLLECTIONS AND FOR FILING OF LIENS; REGULATING THE DISCHARGE OF SANITARY SEWAGE AND INDUSTRIAL WASTES INTO SUCH SEWAGE COLLECTION SYSTEM; ADOPTING CERTAIN RULES AND REGULATIONS AND PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS.

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WHEREAS, This Authority will acquire, construct, own and operate a complete sanitary sewage collection and treatment system and other related facilities for rendering sewage service in and for the Borough of McEwensville, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, This Authority, in accordance with power vested in it by law, desires to fix and charge sewer rates and other charges for use of its sewage collection and treatment facilities and for services rendered by this Authority in connection therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of this Authority, as follows:

SECTION 1  
DEFINITIONS

Unless the context specifically and clearly indicates otherwise, the meaning of terms and phrases used in this Resolution shall be as follows:

A. "Authority" shall mean McEwensville Municipal Authority, a Pennsylvania municipality authority.

B. "Borough" shall mean the Borough of McEwensville, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, a municipality of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, acting by and through its Council or, in the appropriate cases, acting by and through its authorized representatives.

C. "Dwelling Unit" shall mean any room, group of rooms, house trailer or other enclosure occupied or intended for occupancy as separate living quarters by a family or other group of Persons living together or by Persons living alone and also shall mean any room, group of rooms or other enclosure occupied or used as a store, office, profession or other business venture

or used for municipal purposes or as a fire house, clubrooms, church or for any other single purpose.

D. "Improved Property" shall mean any property upon which there is erected a structure intended for continuous or periodic habitation, occupancy or use by human beings or animals and from which structure Sanitary Sewage and/or Industrial Wastes shall be or may be discharged.

E. "Industrial Wastes" shall mean any solid, liquid or gaseous substance or water borne wastes or form of energy rejected or escaping in the course of any industrial, manufacturing, trade or business process or in the course of the development, recovery or processing of natural resources, as distinct from Sanitary Sewage.

F. "Owner" shall mean any Person vested with ownership, legal or equitable, sole or partial, of any Improved Property.

G. "Person" shall mean any individual, partnership, company, association, society, corporation, trust, governmental body, political subdivision, municipality, municipality authority or other group or entity.

H. "Properly Shredded Garbage" shall mean the wastes from the preparation, cooking and dispensing of food that have

been shredded to such a degree that all particles will be carried freely under the flow conditions normally prevailing in the Sewer System, with no particle greater than 1/2 inch (1.27 Centimeters) in any dimension.

I. "Sanitary Sewage" shall mean normal water-carried household and toilet wastes from any Improved Property.

J. "Sewer" shall mean any pipe or conduit constituting a part of the Sewer System used or usable for sewage collection or transportation purposes.

K. "Sewer System" shall mean all facilities, as of any particular time, for collecting, pumping, treating and disposing of Sanitary Sewage and/or Industrial Wastes, acquired, constructed, owned and operated by this Authority.

## SECTION 2

### SEWER RATES AND OTHER CHARGES

Sewer rates and other charges are imposed upon and shall be collected from the Owner of each Improved Property which shall be connected with the Sewer System, for use of the Sewer System, whether such use shall be direct or indirect, which sewer rates and charges shall commence and shall be effective as of the date of connection of each such Improved Property to the Sewer System,

and shall be payable as provided herein, at the annual rate of \$262, payable quarterly at the rate of \$65.50 per quarter for each Dwelling Unit located in each such Improved Property.

Additional classifications for sewer rates and other charges or modifications of the above stated sewer rate may be established by this Authority from time to time as deemed necessary. This Authority specifically reserves the right to impose a volume surcharge and/or to revise the Dwelling Unit classification for any Improved Property discharging Sanitary Sewage and/or Industrial Wastes into the Sewer System.

Nothing contained herein shall be construed as prohibiting special agreements between this Authority and Owners of non-residential Improved Properties under conditions and circumstances making special agreements advisable and necessary.

### SECTION 3

#### TIME AND METHOD OF PAYMENT

A. All bills for sewer rates and charges shall be rendered on the first days of January, April, July and October, respectively, in each year, or as soon after the first day of said months as is possible and shall cover a quarterly billing period consisting of the immediately preceding three calendar months.

Owners of Improved Properties connected to the Sewer System during any calendar quarter shall pay a pro rata sewer rate and charge for service for the balance of the calendar quarter.

B. Sewer rates and other charges shall be due and payable upon the applicable billing date as provided for in subsection A of this Section 3 and the appropriate amount computed in accordance with this Resolution shall constitute the net bill. If sewer rates and charges are not paid within 15 calendar days after each billing date, an additional sum of 5% shall be added to such net bill, which net bill, plus such additional sum, shall constitute the gross bill. Payment made on or mailed and postmarked on or before the last day of such 15 calendar day period shall constitute payment within such period. If the end of such 15 calendar day period shall fall on a legal holiday or a Sunday, payment made on or mailed and postmarked on the next succeeding business day which is not a legal holiday shall constitute payment within such period.

C. Every Owner of an Improved Property which is connected to the Sewer System initially shall provide this Authority with and thereafter shall keep this Authority advised of his correct address. Failure of any Person to receive bills for sewer rates and other charges shall not be considered an excuse for nonpayment nor shall such failure result in an extension of the period of time during which the net bill shall be payable.

SECTION 4  
LIENS FOR SEWER RATES AND OTHER CHARGES;  
FILING AND COLLECTION OF LIENS

Sewer rates and other charges imposed by this Resolution shall be a lien on the Improved Property connected to and served by the Sewer System; and any sewer rates and other charges which are delinquent shall be filed as a lien against the Improved Property connected to and served by the Sewer System, which lien shall be filed and collected in the manner provided by law for the filing and collecting of municipal claims.

SECTION 5  
PROHIBITED WASTES

A. No Person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any storm water, surface water, spring water, ground water, roof runoff, subsurface drainage, building foundation drainage, cellar drainage, drainage from roof leader connections, uncontaminated cooling water or unpolluted process waters into any Sewer.

B. This Authority reserves the right to refuse permission to connect to the Sewer System, to compel discontinuance of use of the Sewer System, or to compel pretreatment of Industrial Wastes, in order to prevent discharges deemed harmful or to have a deleterious effect upon any Sewer or the Sewer System.

C. No Sanitary Sewage or Industrial Wastes shall be discharged to the Sewer System:

- (1) having a temperature higher than 150°F.
- (2) containing more than 100 ppm of fats, wax, tar, oil and/or grease, whether emulsified or not, or containing substances which may solidify or become viscous at temperatures between 32°F and 150°F.
- (3) containing any gasoline, benzine, naphtha, fuel oil or other inflammable or explosive liquids, solids or gases.
- (4) containing any garbage which is not Properly Shredded Garbage.
- (5) containing any ashes, cinders, sand, mud, straw, shavings, metal, glass, rags, cloths, feathers, tar, plastics, wood, paunch manure, whole blood, hair, fleshings, entrails, cotton, wool or other fibers, paper dishes, cups or milk containers, either whole or ground by garbage grinders, or any other solid or viscous substances capable of causing obstructions or other interferences with proper operation of the Sewer System or Sewers.

(6) containing toxic or poisonous solids, liquids or gases in sufficient quantity either singly or by interaction with other wastes, to injure or interfere with any sewage treatment process or to constitute hazards to humans or animals. Toxic wastes shall include, but not by way of limitation, wastes containing cyanide, chromium, copper and/or nickel ions.

(7) sludge, water, solids or other materials pumped from septic tanks.

(8) any waters or wastes containing strong acid iron pickling wastes or concentrated plating solutions, whether neutralized or not.

(9) materials which exert or cause:

(a) unusual concentrations of inert suspended solids (such as, but not limited to, Fullers earth, lime slurries and lime residues) or of dissolved solids (such as, but not limited to, sodium chloride and sodium sulfate); or

(b) excessive discoloration (such as, but not limited to, dye wastes and vegetable tanning solutions).

D. Where necessary all Owners shall install suitable pretreatment facilities in order to comply with subsection C of this Section 5.

Plans, specifications and any other pertinent information relating to proposed facilities for preliminary treatment and handling of wastes shall be submitted for approval of this Authority and no construction of any such facility shall be commenced until approval thereof first shall have been obtained, in writing, from this Authority, and until approval thereof first shall have been obtained from any governmental regulatory body having jurisdiction.

Whenever facilities for preliminary treatment and handling of wastes shall have been provided by any Owner, such facilities continuously shall be maintained, at the expense of such Owner, in satisfactory operating condition; and this Authority shall have access to such facilities at reasonable times for purposes of inspection and testing.

E. No Person shall install or operate in any Improved Property connected to the Sewage Collection System any garbage grinder equipped with a motor of 3/4 horsepower or greater, without prior written approval of this Authority.

F. Nothing contained in this Section 5 shall be construed as prohibiting any special agreement or arrangement between this Authority and any Person whereby Industrial Wastes of unusual strength or character may be admitted into the Sewer System by this Authority, either before or after preliminary treatment.

#### SECTION 6

#### REGULATIONS GOVERNING ADMISSION OF INDUSTRIAL WASTES INTO THE SEWAGE COLLECTION SYSTEM

A. No Person shall discharge or cause to be discharged into the Sewer System any Industrial Wastes except upon application to this Authority and upon receipt of a written permit therefor from this Authority.

B. Required Survey Data.

Any Person desiring to make or use a connection to the Sewer System through which Industrial Wastes shall be discharged into the Sewer System shall file with this Authority an "Industrial Wastes Questionnaire", to be furnished by this Authority, which shall supply to this Authority pertinent data, including estimated quantity of flow, characteristics and constituents, with respect to Industrial Wastes proposed to be discharged into the Sewer System. The cost of obtaining all such data shall be borne by the Person desiring to make or use a connection to the Sewer System.

C. Control Manholes.

Any Person who shall discharge Industrial Wastes into the Sewer System, when required by this Authority, shall construct and thereafter properly shall maintain, at his own expense, a suitable control manhole and other devices as may be approved by this Authority to facilitate observation, measurement and sampling by this Authority of Industrial Wastes discharged to the Sewer System.

Any such control manhole, when required by this Authority, shall be constructed at an accessible, safe, suitable and satisfactory location in accordance with plans approved by this Authority prior to commencement of construction.

D. Changes in Type of Wastes.

Any Person discharging Sanitary Sewage and/or Industrial Wastes into the Sewer System and contemplating a change in the method of operation which will alter the characteristics and/or volumes of wastes at the time being discharged into the Sewer System shall notify this Authority, in writing, at least 10 days prior to consummation of such change.

E. Interceptors.

Grease, oil and sand interceptors shall be provided by the Owner of any Improved Property, when required by this Authority, for the proper handling of liquid wastes containing grease in excessive amounts or any inflammable wastes, sand or other harmful ingredients. Any interceptor, when required by this Authority, shall be of a type and capacity approved by this Authority and constructed or installed at an accessible, safe, suitable and satisfactory location in accordance with plans approved by this Authority prior to installation or commencement of construction.

#### SECTION 7

#### ACCESS

This Authority shall have the right of access at reasonable times to any part of any Improved Property served by the Sewer System and any meters used for purposes of inspection, measurement, sampling and testing and for performance of other functions relating to service rendered by this Authority in connection with the Sewer System.

SECTION 8  
PAYMENT AND DISPOSITION OF  
SEWER RATES AND OTHER CHARGES

All sewer rates and other charges shall be payable to the Treasurer of this Authority or to such other officer or representative of this Authority as shall be authorized, from time to time, by resolution of this Authority, to accept payment thereof. The Treasurer or such other duly authorized officer or representative of this Authority shall deposit all sewer rates and other charges received within 7 days of receipt thereof into the Revenue Fund created under the Resolution of the Authority authorizing the issuance of this Authority's 5% Sewer Revenue Bond - Series of 1983. Until so paid over, the Treasurer or other duly authorized officer or representative of this Authority shall segregate all such sewer rates and other charges so collected in an account separate and distinct from all other funds of this Authority and shall hold the same in trust for purposes set forth in the aforesaid Resolution.

SECTION 9  
ADOPTION OF ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

This Authority reserves the right to adopt, from time to time, such additional rules and regulations as it shall deem necessary and proper in connection with use and operation of the

Sewer System, which rules and regulations shall be, shall become and shall be construed as part of this Resolution.

SECTION 10  
EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution shall become effective immediately.

SECTION 11  
CONSTRUCTION AND SEVERABILITY

In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Resolution, it being the intent of this Authority that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 12  
REPEALER

All other resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent herewith expressly are repealed.
