

Dear Rosemary Chiavetta,

In regards to my PUC Filings, I thought my filings automatically were filed by my insurance company and so did my insurance agent. When I received notification from US DOT that my insurance was going to expire, I contacted my agent, who in turn notified my insurance companies. My auto carrier, Acuity, sent in the filings right away. My cargo carrier, Liberty Mutual, said that they are no longer required to file the cargo. So, I assumed that all was taken care of. I then received a notice from the PUC on 7/15/15 that my authority had been suspended, I contacted my agent again and they went back to my auto carrier, Acuity & told them that the PUC filings needed to be done right away, which they took care of. Nothing was sent to my Cargo carrier, Liberty Mutual, since my agent was informed prior that the cargo filings were no longer required. It wasn't until later, that I received your notice dated 8/1/15, that I was told that Form H did have to be filed for the Cargo. My agent notified Liberty Mutual on 8/7/15 to file Form H & then Liberty Mutual emailed my agent on 8/13/15, that Form H was filed and approved. I think part of the reason that this was all mixed up was that Selective Insurance Company, my previous insurance carrier, continued to do my filings after they no longer insured me. My insurance coverage was moved from Selective effective 12/15/13, but they didn't cancel coverage for my filings until 7/13/15. I believe this is the reason we all thought they were automatically being taken care of and why nothing came up prior to this.

I am asking that the \$500 fine be waived.
