

*We have experienced a high pitched noise in our house that some can hear and some can not. We have had an audio specialist document the presence of a high frequency noise both in and outside the house using a sound meter. We have also experienced light bulbs blowing out and power surges. After working with Peco for over a year to find out the source of the noise and reason for the power surges, a Smart Meter was installed on our home unbeknownst to us and without our permission. Prior to this, I had been stalling this installation for several years and Peco was aware that I did not want this meter on my house.*

*We have become electro-sensitive and have removed all WiFi sources from the home and anything that could add to the magnetic radiation in the environment. With a Smart Meter on our home we have a two way radio signal and radiation going thru us to reach its destination twenty four hours a day. Since the installation of the Smart Meter the noise in the house is worse and we have experienced sleepless nights, heart palpitations, pressure in the chest, etc.*

*Using an RF (radio frequency) meter with headphones we found out that we have the radio station WPST 94.5 playing in our electrical outlets, light fixtures and appliances etc. It is like our house has become an antenna for something! Our home electrical wiring and grounding have been checked by several electricians. The search to find the cause of this noise in and outside the home continues...*

*I would like to have the smart meter taken off my home but PA does not allow an OPT out!*

*State Rep Bob Godshall refuses to look at PA House Bills 396, 393, 399, 395 that would allow Smart Meter opt outs for the utility companies and citizens of Pennsylvania. My health is at risk and I have become electro sensitive. What country do we live in? This certainly not the land of the free!*
