The garbage bags are either long gone or totally ineffective on the crossings that I have viewed. The Department requests that the railroad be required to cover the signals with lockable signal covers that will stay in place. The Department was under the impression that the fate of these crossings would be decided in the year 2000 as per the order. Since there is no end in sight and the railroad seems to want to drag this out indefinitely the District believes that the signal covers should be more than garbage bags that only last until the first strong wind.
