COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement Prosecutory Staff hereby represents as follows:

1. That Barnes Professional Limousine Service, LLC, Respondent, maintains its principal place of business at 3850 Walker Boulevard, Pennsylvania, 16509.
2. That Respondent was issued a certificate of public convenience for group and party 16 or greater authority by this Commission on March 27, 2009 at Application Docket Number A-2009-2094692, authorizing transportation of persons in group and party service in vehicles seating 16 or more, including the driver.
3. That Respondent lists four vehicles on the website that have a capacity of less than fourteen passengers and are advertised as being available for hire.
4. That by performing the act described in paragraph 3, Respondent is offering to render service of a different nature than authorized by Respondent's certificate of service and is in violation of Pa. 66 §1102(a)(1), the penalty for which is \$500.00.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement Prosecutory Staff hereby requests that the Commission fine Barnes Professional Limousine Service the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for the illegal activity described in this Complaint and order such other remedy as the Commission may deem to be appropriate.
