
By Order entered September 17, 2015 ("September 17 Order"), the filing was suspended for a period of up to seven months, or to May 5, 2016. A Suspension Supplement is being filed pursuant to the September 17 Order.

In response to the Commission's Notice, dated September 17, 2015, we hereby advise that AUS consents to the use of the mediation process for the proceeding and, as the party with the burden of proof at the above dockets, AUS agrees to extend the statutory deadline by up to sixty days or to July 4, 2016, provided the other necessary parties consent to mediation for the proceeding.

As previously noted, the Company will file a suspension supplement as well as a supplement to extend the suspension for up to sixty days provided the mediation process will be used for the proceeding. If the Commission requires any additional information, please contact the undersigned.
