





# Overview

- ADL High Voltage Incorporated Company was established in June, 2003. High Voltage's headquarters will be Arlington, Texas.
- High Voltage's primary business is to sell electricity and natural gas to end-use commercial and industrial customers in Texas, then expand into other viable markets throughout the US.
- Texas deregulated its electricity market on January 1, 2002. HVUM is seeking certification as a Retail Electric Provider (REP) in Texas.
- Texas law only allows companies with an REP certificate to buy electricity from the wholesale market and resell it to end-use customers.
- In addition to selling electricity, High Voltage will begin natural gas sales to retail customers in the third quarter of 2004.
- High Voltage expects to be serving 150 customers by 2005 with revenues in excess of \$1 million (.00005% of the total market).

# Deregulation of the Electricity Market

- In June 1999, the Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill 7, which allows electric choice for more than 6.2 million Texas consumers, which began in 2002. In 1996 Pennsylvania enacted its own legislation.


- The Texas Electric Competition Act:

- Requires investor-owned utility companies to break into several new companies
- Allows the retail sale of electricity to become deregulated
- Allows new retail/service companies to sell electricity, provide customer service and handle billing

- The old utilities still exist as the entities that maintain and manage the delivery of electricity (the electric wires that come to your home / business). This function remains regulated.

- Several other states have enacted electricity legislation including Pennsylvania with full competition expected by December, 2010 and Ohio, Massachusetts, Maryland, New York and New Jersey and California.

- Competition has created many good paying jobs and has lowered cost while providing customer flexibility to manage budget.



# Deregulation of the Electricity Market


## What remains the same?

- Traditionally, a local electric utility generates, or purchases from another generator, electricity and delivers it to homes and businesses. The transmission and distribution, or actual delivery of energy, have not changed. The local electric “wires” company, an affiliate of the current electric utility, still provides energy over the same poles and wires used today, and will continue to be regulated by the Public Utility Commission.

# Deregulation of the Electricity Market


## Current Regulated Model

Utilities own all assets (generation / transmission & distribution) rate payers have no choice.



## New Deregulated Model


Utilities must separate into regulated (transmission & distribution) and non-regulated (generation and retail) business units. Rate payers become customers and can choose their electric provider.



A non-profit organization, PJM, acts as the Independent System Operator (ISO) to ensure that all customer transactions are registered and settled fairly. It is also responsible for making sure that all the electricity goes where it's supposed to go.

# Natural Gas Deregulation

- In the early 1990's traditional Pennsylvania natural gas monopolies offered commercial and industrial customers a choice on purchasing their natural gas from third party suppliers to compete for their business.
- The old utilities still exist as the entities that maintain and manage the delivery of natural gas (the gas pipelines that come to your home / business). This function remains regulated.
- Several other states have enacted natural gas legislation including Ohio, NY, NJ, MD, with full competition.
- Competition has created product options and alternatives to buying from traditional utility source and created many good paying jobs and has lowered cost while providing customer flexibility to manage budget.
- The fracking of natural gas in the Marcellus Shale should fuel growth for new supply over the next 20 to 30 years.
- The future long term cost of natural gas should stabilize as a result of advanced fracking technologies to uncover this shale supply of gas.



# Management Team

# Business Model Strategy


