
Since being granted a license by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission in 1998, to provide electric generation supplier services in the Commonwealth, Affiliated Power Purchasers, Inc. (APP) has each year timely filed a renewal of its financial instrument as required by Section 2809(c) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code.

However, the most recent Irrevocable Standby Letter of Credit issued by the Bank of Delmarva on September 1, 2015, on behalf of APP, names the Applicant as "Affiliated Power Purchasers International LLC" instead of the name of "Affiliated Power Purchasers, Inc." which appears on APP's license with the Commission. This discrepancy appears to have recently occurred when APP filed for a name change with the Pennsylvania Department of State on August 10, 2015. This discrepancy is not acceptable, because the name of your company must match exactly with the name on your license issued by the Commission, and in the financial instrument you file with the Commission to insure the security of that license.

What is the correct name of your company? If it is "Affiliated Power Purchasers International LLC, then you must file for a name change with the Commission immediately so the discrepancy can be corrected on your operating license and with the Commission's records. If this correction is swiftly accomplished, there will be no need to change the name on the Letter of Credit issued by the Bank of Delmarva.

Therefore, you are directed to file the correct name of your company and clarify this discrepancy with my office within 10 days of the date of this letter, preferably by overnight delivery.
