Dear Mr. Kaizer:

Please find under cover of this letter the Continuation Certificate recently filed by your company with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission as part of a supplier's license requirements under Section 2809(c) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code.

While the Commission requires a supplier to file an **original** bond, letter of credit, continuation certificate, amendment, or other financial instrument, it also requires that the name of the principal on the financial instrument **match exactly** with the name of the company licensed by the Commission.

The Continuation Certificate you filed does not reflect the correct name of your company according to the Commission's records or your registration with the Pennsylvania Department of State. The Certificate should read "Energy Procurement Partners, Inc." Instead it reads "Energy Procurement Partners, LLC." This is unacceptable and must be corrected as soon as possible. You may file a bond rider to correct the name on your Original Bond Number 0551371, or you may refile a corrected, original Continuation Certificate.

If you wish to change the name of your company, then you must file such changes with the Pennsylvania Department of State and the Commission immediately, and then the current Continuation Certificate would be acceptable.

Therefore, please correct this discrepancy with my office within 20 days of the date of this letter, preferably by overnight delivery. If you have further questions, you may call Shirley Spunaugle, Legal Supervisor at 717-772-7777.
