**THIRD STATUS REPORT RE: DEFERRED DANACH LLC APPLICATION**

On January 20, 2015 Judge Christopher Pell entered an order placing the above referenced application into a stay of further proceeding based on the request of the Applicant and the status of other Uber related Commission activity. As part of that order Judge Pell has requested that the Applicant provide a status report every sixty days until the matter is placed back on the dockets.

The Applicant reports as follows:

1. On January 29, 2015 after a recommended decision, a subsequent final decision from the Commission and the completion of a compliance plan, Rasier-PA LLC, a wholly owned Uber subsidiary was granted experimental authority by the Commission to operate in most of the counties of the Commonwealth including those sought by Danach LLC here
2. The operation of the experimental authority and its coordination with the compliance plan is moving forward through cooperative development form the Commission and Rasier-PA
3. Legislation has been developed to take this new authority from experimental to a transportation authorized by the Legislature and regulated by the appropriate agency
4. As anticipated in the last report Legislation has been introduced into the Legislature and several bills are being considered by the House of Representatives, one of which was discussed in depth at a public hearing before the Committee on Consumer Affairs
5. Unfortunately, the budget for the Commonwealth still remains unresolved and this legislation, along with many other bills, have taken a back seat while the Legislature handles that battle.
6. The Legislature has recently returned from recess and the bill is undergoing the scrutiny of the House and Senate Committees where they were introduced.
7. Alternate language for the bills are now being exchanged between the stakeholders and the respective Legislative Committees

8. It is uncertain at this point when this Legislation will be introduced for a vote but all parties are working together to ensure its passage in short time
9. The development of this Legislation will govern how Danach LLC will operate in conjunction with this experimental authority or whether there will be a need for the authority at all
10. The Applicant still desires to obtain limousine authority with the Commission but seeks to continue the stay of proceedings until the Legislation is finalized and it is determined as to the necessity of service and eliminate any further time and expense that would be expended in litigating the Application at this time
11. The Applicant will file its next report by December 10, 2015 as ordered by Judge Pell unless terminating Application or ordered differently.
