TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:


On March 22, 2006, the parties to the above-captioned matter requested an extension of time in which to file an amended interconnection agreement for Commission approval. By Opinion and Order entered February 21, 2006, the Commission directed that the parties file the amended interconnection agreement by March 23, 2006.

The parties indicate that they have not yet reached consensus regarding the drafting of the agreement, although discussions continue. The parties reference the complexity of the issues and the number of parties involved as justification of their request.

Given that the parties are in agreement of the need for the extension and the limited extension requested, the request for extension is granted. The parties are required to file an amended interconnection agreement that is consistent with our February 21, 2006 Order *no later than April 27, 2006*.

Upon the filing of the amended interconnection agreement and its subsequent approval, as specified in our February 21, 2006 Order, this proceeding will be marked closed.
