Dear Justin,

National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation ("NFGDC") is aware Titan Energy - New England, Inc. (TENE) has filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to supply natural gas service to the public in Pennsylvania and specifically within the service territory of NFGDC.

As you know, in making such an application, TENE must furnish acceptable security to each utility where TENE will do business. As such, under its tariff, NFGDC could require TENE to provide a bond or other financial security instrument in an amount that NFGDC determines to be appropriate.

However, you have indicated, and it is NFGDC's understanding that TENE intends only to provide natural gas aggregating, brokering and consulting services at this time. You have stated that, in performing these services, TENE will never take title to any delivered natural gas.

Based upon your representations, NFGDC has determined that, at this time, TENE does not need to post a bond or other form of security to operate in its service territory. However, if the services provided by TENE change in the future, NFGDC reserves the right to require security from TENE as it deems appropriate.

Dear Mr. Hawkins:

On November 29, 2010, Titan Energy-New England, Inc. (Titan Energy) filed with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) an application for renewal registration as a natural gas aggregator dated November 16, 2010, along with a check for the application renewal fee in the amount of \$125.

The Commission has reviewed Titan Energy's renewal application for registration as a natural gas aggregator and has determined that its application meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05 (Adopted Rule 9/24/10). Accordingly, the Commission has approved Titan Energy as a natural gas aggregator in the State of New Hampshire, effective January 11, 2011, which coincides with the expiration of Titan Energy's current aggregator registration. The renewed registration will expire at the end of business on January 10, 2016.


Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05 (a) and (e), each aggregator must re-register after the initial 2 year period or after a 5 year renewal period as applicable by filing with the Commission an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration and notify any LDC in whose service territory it intends to do business of the filing of its registration or renewal application at the time it files such an application with the Commission. Titan Energy's application for renewal would be due November 10, 2015. We urge Titan Energy to make a timely renewal filing in 2015. ORDER

By the Commission:

I. PRELIMINARY MATTERS

On July 15, 2010, Titan Energy - New England, Inc. ("Applicant") filed a verified application with the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") requesting a certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant ("ABC") in Illinois pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Public Utilities Act ("Act"), 220 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 454 ("Part 454"). In its Application, the Applicant indicated that it is licensed in twelve other jurisdictions as a broker/marketer of natural gas or electricity, and that it has had no complaints filed against it for its provision of services in the gas or electric industry. Applicant requests authority to offer services as an ABC for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois.

II. REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS UNDER SECTION 16-115C OF THE ACT

Applicant is a business organized under the laws of Connecticut and licensed to transact business in Illinois. Applicant has certified that it will comply with all applicable regulations; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements established by Commission rule; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Act; and that it will comply with all other applicable laws, regulations, terms, and conditions required to the extent they have application to the services being offered by an ABC. Applicant has agreed to ensure that any person who acts on its behalf will comply with all applicable sections of Part 454. Applicant agrees that it will remain in compliance with the provisions of the Act and Part 454, and will ensure that authorizations received from customers, and all other applicable records are retained for a period of not less than three calendar years after the calendar year in which they were created. Applicant has agreed to adopt and follow rules and procedures to preserve the confidentiality of its customers' data.

III. FINANCIAL, TECHNICAL, AND MANAGERIAL REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 16-115C

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 454.80 of Part 454, Applicant provided a surety bond in the amount of \$5,000 issued by a qualifying surety authorized to transact business in Illinois. Applicant submitted an original surety bond in satisfaction of Section 454.80.

Applicant is required by Part 454.60 to demonstrate that it meets the managerial qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant must further provide an organizational chart that indicates the position of persons which satisfy the managerial qualification. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the managerial qualifications set forth in Part 454.60, as demonstrated in Attachment 1. Attachment 1 includes an exhibit containing a corporate organizational chart and identifying the persons who are being used to meet the requirements of Part 454.60(a). Attachment 1 includes an exhibit containing occupational background information on the person or persons who are being used to meet the requirements of Part 454.60(a).

Applicant is required by Part 454.70 to demonstrate that it meets the technical qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the technical qualifications set forth in Part 454.70 with the information provided, including the information included in Attachment 1. Attachment 1 includes an exhibit containing occupational background information on the person or persons who are being used to meet the requirements of Part 454.70(a).

Applicant further agrees to comply with the Code of Conduct for ABCs contained in Section 454.90.

IV. COMMISSION CONCLUSION AND CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

The Commission has reviewed the application and attachments along with the supplementary information provided by Applicant regarding the technical and managerial requirements and all other requirements of the Act and Part 454 and finds that the Applicant sufficiently demonstrates compliance with the requirements.

The Commission concludes, therefore, that Applicant's request for a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC in Illinois should be granted and should include the following authority:

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

IT IS CERTIFIED that Titan Energy - New England, Inc. is granted service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois.

V. FINDINGS AND ORDERING PARAGRAPHS

The Commission, having reviewed the entire record, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) Titan Energy - New England, Inc., a business organized under the laws of Connecticut, seeks a certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant under Section 16-115C of the Act;
- (2) the Commission has jurisdiction over the party hereto and the subject matter hereof;
- (3) the recitals of fact and conclusions reached in the prefatory portion of this Order are supported by the record and are hereby adopted as findings of fact;
- (4) Applicant has demonstrated that it possesses sufficient financial, managerial and technical resources and abilities to provide services as an agent, broker or consultant for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply to third parties in the State of Illinois;
- (5) Applicant has complied with Section 16-115C of the Act and Part 454; and
- (6) Titan Energy - New England, Inc. should be granted the certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant as specified in this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Illinois Commerce Commission that Titan Energy - New England, Inc. is hereby granted a Certificate of Service Authority authorizing it to operate as an agent, broker or consultant; said Certificate of Service Authority shall read as that set forth in Section IV of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Titan Energy - New England, Inc. shall comply with all applicable Commission rules and orders now and as hereafter amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, subject to the provisions of Section 10-113 of the Public Utilities Act and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.880, this Order is final; it is not subject to the Administrative Review Law.

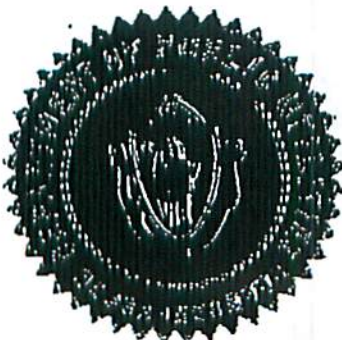

DECISION

I. INTRODUCTION

A. SUMMARY

In this Decision, the Department of Public Utility Control grants The Energy Authority – New England, Inc. an Electric Aggregator Certificate of Registration to serve commercial, industrial, municipal and governmental customers in Connecticut.

B. BACKGROUND OF THE PROCEEDING

By application filed February 22, 2007 (Application) pursuant to § 16-245(l) of the General Statutes of Connecticut (Conn. Gen. Stat.), The Energy Authority – New England, Inc. (TEA or Company) applied to the Department of Public Utility Control (Department) for a registration to operate as an electric aggregator within Connecticut.

C. CONDUCT OF THE PROCEEDING

No Party requested a hearing. The Department determined that a hearing was not necessary in this matter; and thus, none was held. Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-245(l)(4).

D. PARTIES TO THE PROCEEDING

The Department recognized The Energy Authority – New England, Inc., 2317 Silas Deane Highway, Rocky Hill, Connecticut 06027; and the Office of Consumer Counsel, Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut 06051, as Parties to the proceeding.

II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

TEA proposed to serve commercial, industrial, municipal and governmental customers throughout Connecticut. TEA's headquarters are located at 2317 Silas Deane Highway, Rocky Hill, Connecticut 06027. The Company's main telephone number is 860-436-2378. TEA is a corporation formed on September 26, 2002, in Connecticut. Its contact person for regulatory matters is John F. Kearney, Jr. Application, p. 1. TEA provided its Certificate of Incorporation and Business Registration with the State of Connecticut. Application, Exhibit A-10. TEA indicated that it has no affiliates. Application, Exhibit A-11. TEA also provided its most recent financial statements for the year 2006. Application, Exhibit A-12.

Pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-245(l)(3), the Company disclosed that neither TEA nor any of its affiliates are currently under investigation or have ever been fined, sanctioned or penalized in any state for violation of any consumer protection law or regulation. Application, A-14 and A-15. Further, TEA affirmed that it will comply with the National Labor Relations Act and the Connecticut Unfair Trade Practices Act and applicable regulations. Application, Affidavit #2.

In Response to CA-2, TEA indicated that they have confirmed with each electric supplier that the information required in Section 16-245-3(d) of the Regulations of State Agencies will be mailed to the customer. However, pursuant to this section, within 60 days after an aggregated customer contracts with an electric supplier, and within 60 days after any renewal, extension or modification of such contract, the electric aggregator is required to issue to the aggregated customer a notice containing the following information:

- (1) The name, address and toll-free customer service telephone number of the electric supplier that provides electric generation services under its aggregation offer; and
- (2) The rate for electric generation services stated in its aggregation offer, or a description of how electric generation services are charged to customers under its aggregation offer.

Therefore, no later than 30 days from the date of this decision, the Department will require TEA to submit a sample copy of the notice required by section 16-245-3(d) that TEA will issue aggregated customers.

III. CONCLUSION AND ORDERS

A. CONCLUSION

After reviewing the Application, the Department grants TEA a Certificate of Registration to provide electric aggregation services to commercial, industrial, municipal and governmental customers in the state of Connecticut. TEA is reminded that it is under a continuing obligation to notify the Department of any changes to the information provided in the Application.

B. ORDERS

1. TEA shall provide the Department with any changes to its customer service practices, procedures, or policies in writing at least ten (10) business days prior to the effective date of such changes.
2. TEA shall maintain its customer complaint records to indicate: (1) the date of the complaint; (2) the name and address of the complainant; (3) the address or location of the complaint; (4) a description of the complaint; and (5) a description of the resolution of the complaint.
3. No later than 30 days from the date of this decision, the Department will require TEA to submit a sample copy of the notice required by section 16-245-3(d).





ORDER GRANTING LICENSE

I. SUMMARY

In this Order, we license Titan Energy – New England, Inc. (TENE) to operate as a competitive electricity provider furnishing aggregator/broker services in Maine pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules.

II. APPLICATION AND DECISION

On January 28, 2011, TENE applied to the Commission to operate in Maine as a competitive electricity provider pursuant to Chapter 305. TENE proposes to provide aggregator/broker services to non-residential customers in the service territories of Central Maine Power Company, Bangor Hydro-Electric Company, Maine Public Service Company and Kennebunk Light and Power District. TENE met all the Chapter 305 filing requirements. As a licensed competitive electricity provider, TENE is required to comply with all applicable requirements and regulations, including all conditions of licensing, customer protection rules, and the filing of annual reports.

Pursuant to a Delegation Order dated April 23, 2008 in Docket No. 2008-185, *PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION, Delegation of Authority to License Competitive Electricity Providers*, the Commission delegated to the Director of Technical Analysis the authority under 35-A M.R.S.A., § 3203 (1)(2) and Chapter 305, §2 to license competitive electricity providers. On September 12, 2009, in Docket No. 2009-260, statutory changes took effect that change the title of this position. P.L. 2009, ch. 122. The Director of Technical Analysis will be the Director of Electric and Gas Utility Industries. All existing delegation orders that delegate Commission authority to the Director of Technical Analysis will now read that we delegate our authority to the Director of Electric and Gas Utility Industries.


Accordingly, it is
