By letter dated January 25, 2002, the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA), an intervenor in this proceeding, requests, on behalf of all parties, an indefinite suspension of the litigation schedule of this proceeding. The parties have reached an agreement in principle which requires Pennsylvania-American Water Company to apply for a Penn Vest loan by the next deadline in May 2002. In its letter, OCA states that the parties will submit a status report in May 2002 and advise if the litigation schedule needs to be reinstated.


I will grant the request and have the hearings scheduled for February 26-27, 2002, canceled. If the parties consummate the settlement, the proceeding should be closed pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.24.

In consideration of the foregoing;

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the litigation schedule in this proceeding is suspended indefinitely.
2. That in May 2002 the parties submit a status report to me in writing.
3. That if the parties consummate a settlement in this proceeding, they make the appropriate submission pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.24.
