

To Whom it May Concern;

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I. BACKGROUND

Pursuant to 052 PA Code § 5.365, Orders to limit availability of proprietary information, Energy Professionals, LLC is submitting the following information in support of its Application Form for Parties Wishing to Offer, Render, Furnish, or Supply Natural Gas Supply Services to the Public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (Application). Energy Professionals, LLC is a nonselling marketer, as that term is defined in the Application, under contract to multiple NGS entities.

II. LEGAL STANDARD

052 PA Code § 5.365(a) provides in pertinent part:

A petition for protective order to limit the disclosure of a trade secret or other confidential information on the public record will be granted only when a party demonstrates that the potential harm to the party of providing the information would be substantial and that the harm to the party if the information is disclosed without restriction outweighs the public's interest in free and open access to the administrative hearing process. A protective order to protect trade secrets or other confidential information will apply the least restrictive means of limitation which will provide the necessary protections from disclosure. In considering whether a protective order to limit the availability of proprietary information should be issued, the Commission or the presiding officer should consider, along with other relevant factors, the following:

1. The extent to which the disclosure would cause unfair economic or competitive damage.
2. The extent to which the information is known by others and used in similar activities.
3. The worth or value of the information to the party and to the party's competitors.
4. The degree of difficulty and cost of developing the information.

5. Other statutes or regulations dealing specifically with disclosure of the information.

III. BASIS FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT

The materials proposed for redaction constitute trade secrets and confidential financial information. The potential damage of publicly releasing such trade secret information would give competitors an advantage, **the disclosure of which would cause unfair economic or competitive damage to Energy Professionals, LLC.**

In addition, the confidential information provided in the Application are not known by others and used in similar activities. Further, the materials proposed for redaction are not contained in materials which are available to the general public, and not routinely provided to public agencies, absent a protective order. Such information is not public knowledge and needs to remain confidential to preserve Energy Professionals LLC's competitive advantage.

Release of the confidential information subject of this request for a protective order would potentially damage Energy Professionals, as the company has worked for over a decade to cultivate its relationships with suppliers and it is of the utmost importance that these remain confidential. As such, Energy Professionals, LLC takes extensive measures to prevent disclosure of its financial and proprietary information to others. Such precautions include, but are not limited to, the use of confidentiality agreements with Energy Professionals, LLC employees and independent contractors, non-disclosure agreements with parties Energy Professionals, LLC seeks to transact business with, and seeking protective orders with agencies such as the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commissions to prevent the publication of such documents. **The worth or value of the information to Energy Professionals, LLC and to its competitors is extremely high.**

As referenced above, Energy Professionals, LLC has worked for over a decade to cultivate its relationships with suppliers and to develop a way of operating that has been very successful to Energy Professionals, LLC. There has been a high **degree of difficulty and cost of developing the information.** As such, it is of the utmost importance that the information provided remain confidential.

As referenced above and because of the need to keep certain information confidential for competitive purposes, Energy Professionals routinely seeks confidential treatment. For example, Energy Professionals, LLC has sought protection from other statutes or regulations dealing specifically with disclosure of the information, including, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.)

IV. CONCLUSION

Based on the foregoing, the potential harm to Energy Professionals, LLC of providing the information it seeks to protect would be substantial and the harm to Energy Professionals, LLC if the information is disclosed without restriction outweighs the public's interest in free and open access to the administrative hearing process. The protective order Energy Professionals, LLC seeks to protect its trade secrets or other confidential information is the least restrictive means of limitation which will provide the necessary protections from disclosure.

Accordingly, Energy Professionals, LLC requests that the Commission grant protective treatment to confidential un-redacted Exhibits C (organization structure) and D (balance sheets and income statements for the past two years).

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Energy Professionals, LLC respectfully requests that the Commission grant its request for an order to limit availability of proprietary information for an interminable period.

Any NGS suppliers and/or broker/marketers that wish to use the Electronic Data Interchange (EDI), in the NGDCs where its available, must meet the EDI certification requirements of the NGDC. Certification is a testing process using the Commission approved Internet protocol. To initiate this process, the NGS is encouraged to contact the NGDC as early as possible after filing an application for a license with the Commission, since certification may require as many as four months to complete and customer service contract dates may not commence prior to certification. NGDC requirements of new suppliers may be found on the respective NGDC home web page. Pennsylvania's industry stakeholder group the Electronic Data Exchange Working Group (EDEWG) develops and maintains the EDI transactions and related business practices, which are found on the Pa. PUC website at http://www.puc.pa.gov/filing_resources/issues_laws_regulations/electronic_data_exchange.aspx. The EDEWG meets telephonically the first Thursday of each month at 2:00pm ET to discuss EDI change control requests and other issues.

By this Order, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("Commission") grants a license to Energy Professionals, LLC ("Energy Professionals" or "Applicant") to function as a natural gas supplier in the District of Columbia.¹ Specifically, Energy Professionals intends to operate as a broker of natural gas for distribution to residential, commercial and industrial customers in the District of Columbia, pursuant to the licensing requirements set forth in GT 96-3, Order No. 12903.²

2. On April 11, 2012,³ Energy Professionals filed its license application. Pursuant to the Commission's licensing requirements as set forth in Order Nos. 12709 and 12903 in GT 96-3,⁴ Energy Professionals provided the following information:

- a) Proof of technical and managerial competence;
- b) Affidavit of compliance with applicable Federal and District of Columbia environmental laws and regulations dated March 30, 2012;
- c) Proof of financial integrity to include financial statements;
- d) Proof that Energy Professionals has registered with the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs to do business in the District of Columbia;
- e) Affidavits stating that Energy Professionals is subject to all applicable taxes;
- f) Affidavits dated March 30, 2012, stating that Energy Professionals will comply with all the requirements of all orders and regulations of the Commission; and

On May 21, 2015, Energy Professionals, LLC (Energy Professionals), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) an application for a competitive natural gas provider (CNGP) certificate to provide CNGP service to large and small volume customers in Iowa. The Board's certification rules provide that the certification application review process is based on a 90-day clock that begins once the applicant is notified that the application is complete. 199 IAC 19.14(4). On June 18, 2015, the Board notified Energy Professionals that its application was complete, and the review process timeline had commenced. The 90-day deadline for the Board to act on the application is September 16, 2015.

On June 10, 2015, the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA), a division of the Iowa Department of Justice, filed a response to Energy Professionals' application for a CNGP certificate. In the response, OCA states that it does not object to the application.

Iowa Code § 476.87 requires that an applicant for a CNGP certificate must reasonably demonstrate that it has the managerial, technical, and financial capability sufficient to obtain and deliver the services it proposes to offer. Subrule

199 IAC 19.14(3) describes the basic information that is required to be provided by an applicant for a CNGP certificate. The Board also has developed application forms that describe additional information that must be provided depending on the type of CNGP service that is proposed to be provided.

The Board reviewed the information provided by Energy Professionals to meet the requirements of Iowa Code § 476.87 and Board CNGP rules and is issuing an order concurrently with this certificate approving Energy Professionals' application for a certificate to serve large and small volume customers in Iowa. The Board will issue Certificate No. G-0046 to Energy Professionals, which authorizes the provision of competitive natural gas services to large and small volume customers as an aggregator. If Energy Professionals decides to take title to natural gas, Energy Professionals will need to file an application for an amended certificate.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

This certificate as a competitive natural gas provider, issued pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.87 (2015), authorizes Energy Professionals, LLC, to furnish competitive natural gas service as an aggregator to large and small volume customers in Iowa.

Dear Mr. Upham:

On July 17, 2012, Energy Professionals, LLC (Energy Professionals) filed with the Commission an application for renewal of its registration as a natural gas aggregator, together with the renewal application fee of \$125.00. This application was re-filed and updated by Energy Professionals by filings made on September 6, 2012 and October 19, 2012, in response to a Staff deficiency letter dated August 15, 2012.

Commission Staff notes that Energy Professionals' original registration as an aggregator expired on August 13, 2012, only 29 days after Energy Professionals filed its renewal application with the Commission. Despite this oversight, Commission Staff has determined that the renewal application for registration as a natural gas aggregator, as re-filed and updated, meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05. On November 8, 2012, Staff filed its recommendation to approve the application, with the expectation that Energy Professionals will remain cognizant of Commission requirements for registration renewal going forward. The Commission will approve the registration with an effective date of August 13, 2012, which coincides with the expiration of the existing registration for Energy Professionals. The renewal registration will expire at the end of business on August 12, 2017.

Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05 (a), each aggregator shall re-register with the Commission by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of Energy Professionals, on or before June 12, 2017. Please file a timely renewal application.

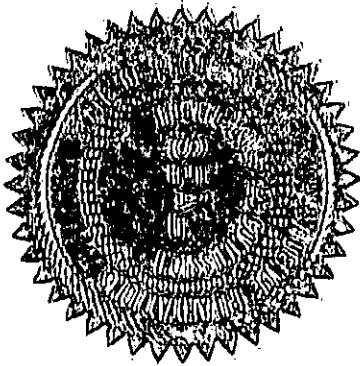


