

Hill Street Crossing (Borough of Duryea street)

23. Pursuant to the Commission Order dated May 4, 1970 at Application Docket No. 95397, Paragraph twenty-three, Reading, Blue Mountain and Northern Railroad Company, where it crosses at the grade of Hill Street in the Borough of Duryea, Luzerne County at its sole cost and expense shall tighten the west rail at the at Hill Street crossing, repair or replace the roadway paving adjacent to the rails and the guard timbers which is severely deteriorated with potholes and ruts and restore the area of the highway disturbed by the repairs with bituminous concrete or other suitable material, in the crossing area between the rails and for two feet outside of each rail, in compliance with local municipality criteria or the criteria of the Department of Transportation. Reading, Blue Mountain and Northern Railroad Company, at the grade of Hill Street, at its sole cost and expense shall maintain the crossing pavement between the rails and for a distance of at least two feet beyond each outside rail.

24. Pursuant to Paragraph fourteen of the order dated May 4, 1970 at Application Docket No. 95397, the Borough of Duryea shall at its sole cost and expense repair the roadway approaches by filling in the potholes and rutted areas and maintain the roadway approaches to the crossing to a point two feet outside of the remaining rails.

25. Reading, Blue Mountain and Northern Railroad Company, where it crosses at the grade of Hill Street in the Borough of Duryea, Luzerne County at its sole cost and expense shall maintain the Cross-buck warning signs which protect the crossing at Hill Street.
