Several months ago, I had a hearing with PECO Energy regarding a billing balance that was in delinquency. It was decided that a balance of \$360. a month would be paid to settle the debt. However, even though I work part-time, the bulk of my income still comes from my disability. After paying my mortgage (\$783/a month) and the Peco amount (\$360/a month), I barely have enough to pay my other utilities, car insurance, homeowners insurance, food, medicine, etc. I stated to the presiding judge at the hearing, it would be economically feasible for me to pay \$180- \$190/month. This would help me greatly, as I have every desire to pay back this debt. I was informed by PECO that my Deferment Plan could be reinstated with the payment of \$75.00 towards my next bill. If my Deferment amount can be set to \$180.00/month, that would be no problem. Thank you,
