JUDGE NGUYEN: We are going to open the record for the hearing of Richard Caroto against Philadelphia Gas Works, at Docket number C-20066256. My name is Ky Van Nguyen. I am the Administrative Law Judge presiding at this hearing. I would ask the parties to identified themselves for the record. Mr. Caroto, can you identify yourself?

MR. CAROTO: My name is Richard Caroto. I live at 1304 Rose Tree Lane in Havertown, Pennsylvania, 19083.

JUDGE NGUYEN: Mr. Farinas?

MR. FARINAS: Good morning, your Honor. Laureto Farinas, Counsel for the Philadelphia Gas Works. And with me today is Wendy Vodka, a customer review unit officer with PGW.

JUDGE NGUYEN: Thank you. Can you tell me about the agreement you made

1 with Mr. Caroto?

2 MR. FARINAS: Yes, your Honor. I'm
3 happy to report to you that Mr. Caroto
4 has once again graciously agreed to
5 settle this matter with PGW. Since
6 your interim order of July 14th undid
7 our previous settlement the new
8 settlement will be that PGW will credit
9 Mr. Caroto's account in the amount of
10 \$267.22, which actually results in a
11 credit amount of \$200 toward him, which
12 I will deem this as a request for a
13 refund since he's no longer a gas
14 customer.

15 JUDGE NGUYEN: Is that agreeable to
16 you, Mr. Caroto?

17 THE WITNESS: Yes. My
18 understanding from talking to you is
19 that what they're doing is legal. So,
20 yes, that's a fine settlement.

21 JUDGE NGUYEN: Okay. Thank you.
22 We are adjourned.

23 MR. FARINAS: Thank you, your
